The purpose of this letter is to inform you that following an extensive review and vetting of the submitted bids, it was determined by the MTA Office of Fair Practice that due to an error in the wording of paragraph 9.A. in the Invitation to Bidders, all bids must be rejected and the project rebid. The inclusion of the wording "exceed" by MTA in the first paragraph was an error and therefore rendered the bid results unacceptable. The project will be rebid with this wording removed.

We hope your firm will consider participating in the rebid process. The dates are as follows:

Attached is the revised Invitation to Bid which has been modified to revise the instructions accordingly. In an effort to minimize the inconvenience and work effort involved with this rebid, we have also deleted the pre-bid meeting for this round as no changes, other than the wording noted above, are involved. We will again stress to all bidders the need to ensure proper completion of all the DBE forms to ensure the 24% DBE goal is correctly calculated and accounted for.
